- 8. A vase of ornamental foliage**
- 9. A bowl of floating flowers (max bowl width 20cm)**
- 10. A fuschia in a pot (max pot size 20cm)**
- 11. A pelagonium in a pot (max pot size 20cm)**
- 12. A vase of 5 stems sweet peas**
- 13. Any other flowering pot plant (max pot size 20cm)**
- 14. A foliage pot plant (max pot size 20cm)**
- 15. A vase of flowers of one colour**
- 16. A dinner table decoration, mainly plant based (to fit table space of 20cm x 20cm)**

Note 2: Show us what you bake with your fruit and vegetable glut:

A 20cm slab cake, recipe of your choice, the predominant ingredient being fruit or vegetable eg. apple, carrot, parsnip, courgette, beetroot etc.

Iced and decorated optional, but your cake will be judged on interesting flavour and texture combo.

Present on a paper plate, with cake ingredients listed. In the interest of hygiene, please cover with cling film or clear plastic/ glass cover.

Any cake entries will be used for afternoon refreshments.

Note 3: Materials used to be grown by or foraged for, but not bought by the exhibitor

RULES

- 1. Entry of exhibits restricted to members of Malvern Hills Gardening Club**
- 2. All exhibits are to be grown by the exhibitor (with the exception of D3, see Note 3 above)**
- 3. Only one entry per class per household, except for Special Classes (Section D)**
- 4. Entries to be received by 9pm on Wednesday 19th August**
- 5. Staging of entries will be from 10:30am - 12 noon on Saturday, 22nd August**
- 6. Exhibitors to provide their own vase/ containers**
- 7. Exhibits are staged at exhibitors' own risk**
- 8. The Judges' decision is final**
- 9. Exhibits and cards to be removed immediately after presentation of awards**
- 10. No plastic containing floral foam (eg Oasis) to be used.
Exhibits containing this will not be judged**
